

#### 6. AIMS & OBJECTS OF THE TRUST:

The TRUSTEES shall spend, utilizes and apply the Trust fund for all or any one or more of the under mentioned charitable objects and purposes or such other charitable objects, beneficial to public, as the trustees may think proper and in such manner in all respects as the trustees may in their absolute description deem fit and proper.

- A. The spread or promotion of education or learning in all its branches in such manner as the Trustees may think fit including:
- (i) (a) Establishment and/or acquisition and maintenance or support of Schools & Hostels.
- (b) Establishment and maintenance of College, Vidyapiths, balmandirs study centers, Universities and professional Educational Training centre and other Educational Training to students.
- (c) Establishment of preschool and early child hood education center.
- (ii) Establishment and support of professorships, fellowships, lectureships, scholarships, and prizes at schools, colleges or other educational institutions.
- (iii) Establishment and maintenance of Hostels and/or Boarding Houses and grant of free boarding an lodging to poor and deserving students upon such period to each case as the trustees may think fit.
- (iv) Establishment and maintenance of any support of naturopathy and yoga, Health centers and similar Institutions for the education of the same.
- (v) Grant or Endowments at universities, Research institutions and other education and knowledge in all or any branches.

- (viii) Education in health, hygiene and sanitation, especially in the rural areas.
- (ix) To set up educational institution, informal education, management college, colleges for technical education and other professional educational colleges.

(xi) To work in filed of health for physical, mental and intellectual development of malnourished children, women and their rehabilitation.

- (xii) To establish nutrition centers for the pregnant women and children. Also to educate them in the value of nutrition and upbringing of children.
- (xiii) To work towards eradication and prevention of AIDS.
- (xiv) Establishment, maintenance and support of A.N.M./Asha/Anganwari workers Educational Training Institute and Para Medical Institute.

- (v) To implement programmes for financial, social and cultural development or tribal including protection of the original culture of the tribes.

#### (C) TREASURER

- (i) To keep account of income expenses and the conveyance meeting to consent with Chairman.
- (ii) To deposit the assets of trust in bank and post office.

### 10. Power & function of the trustees:

- (a) The TRUSTEES shall be at liberty, at their absolute discretion to accept any property, contribution, grants, collection or donations from persons, firms, companies or government or other institution, including foreign agencies/institution or foreign governments, for the advancements of the objects of the Trust.
- (b) , To trustees shall be entitled from time to time to open and maintain bank accounts in the name of the Trust with a bank or banks, to operate such account(s) and to give instruction to the bank(s) and to provide for opening and operation of such accounts(s) by the Trustee. The bank accounts shall be open by two trustees namely Chairman or Secretary and Treasurer and Operation of the Accounts will be operated jointly by.
- (c) The Trustees may borrow or raise moneys or funds from banks, financial institutions, government, other institution, persons, firms and companies for the purposes and the objects of the Trust, on such terms and conditions as they may think fit in the interest of the trust and mortgage, pledge or otherwise secure all or any of the properties or investments of the Trust as a security against such borrowings.
- (d) The Trustees shall be at liberty to sell and/or realise the Trust Property, if and when acquire, in future or funds and invest the sale proceeds thereof or any other moneys, being part of the Trust Fund, in any manner as the Trustees may from time to time think fit, within the scope of this Trust and within the scope of law.
- (e) The Trustees may lend money either with or without security.

- The Trustees may create a corpus fund out of any specific grant or donation or out of the income of the Trust and invent the same in suitable long terms investments and may out of the corpus of the trust spend such money or out of the sale proceeds or any part thereof appropriate such money or part thereof for all or any of the charitable objects, and purposes of the Trust.
- (h) The Managing Trustee or the Trustees may appoint regular, permanent, part-time or honorary staff, if necessary and according to the requirement for managing or working of the trust and use the Trust funds for payment of their salaries, compensation, expenses etc.
- The Trustees may let or hire out any movable or (i) immovable properties belonging to the Trust for such period and at such rent or charge and on such terms and conditions as the Trustees in their discretion may think fit in the interest of the Trust.
- The Trustees may construct, laboratories, buildings dispensaries, Homoeo Paithics, Ayurved Electropathic, clinics, operating theaters, hospital, eye-banks and/or purchase or take on lease of any of all of them and such other equipment, instruments, apparatus, machinery, and/or vehicles as may be necessary for carrying out the objects and purposes of the Trust.
- The Trustee may subject to the provisions of law, (k) contribute to the funds of any professional association, individual, firm, corporate body, society, organisation or institution, which in the opinion of the Trustees is beneficial to the Trust.
- The Trustee may conduct workshops, conferences, (1) seminars, meetings, forms, symposia and create opportunities for medical professional, researchers, scholars, technicians and

interested persons to meet regularly to exchange view, notes, research findings and inventions and to publish newsletters, books, magazines, periodical and/or leaflets related to the aims, objects and purposes of the Trust.

- (m) The Trustees may reimburse themselves for all expenses actually incurred or spent by them in connection with the Trust or affairs of the Trust or that duties relative thereto.
- (n) The Trustees may join, co-operate or amalgamate this Trust with other.
- (o) The Trustees may institute, defend, adjust, settle compromise, compound, refer to arbitration, all actions, suits, claims demands and proceedings regarding the Trust property or the Trust funds.
- (p) The Trustees may appoint constituted attorney(s) or agent(s) and to delegate to such attorney(s) or agent(s) all or any of the powers vested in them under this Trust Deed and from time to time remove such attorney(s) or agent(s) and to appoint other or others in his or their place(s).
- (q) The Trustees have power to frame rules and regulations to carry out and to give effect to the objects and the purposes of the Trust and/or managing the affairs of the Trust and to alter, and or amend the same from time to time.
- (r) The Trustees may do any other thing or things which is/are incidental and conducive to the attainment of aims and objects or any one of them.

# 11. MEETING:

- (a) The Managing Trustee for the time being shall be authorised to call a meeting of the Trustees by giving notice in writing or oral to the other Trustees.
- (b) Managing Trustee along with two of the Trustees shall form a quorum for a meeting of the Trustees.

- (c) All matters will be decided unanimously by the Managing Trustee and the majority of the Trustee at a meeting convened for that purpose.
- (d) Resolution may be passed without holding a meeting of the Trustees by circulating in writing the proposed resolution, which must be endorsed by the Managing Trustees and two third of the Trustees. If resolutions are endorsed in this manner, they shall be as valid and effectual as resolutions passed at a meeting of the Trustees.
- (e) The Trustees shall keep or cause to be kept a minute book of the proceedings of the meetings.
- Trust and transfer the trust and/or such pat of portion thereof as shall for the time being remain in the hands of the Trustees, or the investment and properties of the Trust or a part thereof to any other Institutions or trust for pursing the objects specified but not part of the trust funds, assets or liabilities shall be transferred to the settler or any of the Trustees at any time or under any circumstances, upon dissolution.

# 12. FINANCE & ACCOUNTS:

- (a) It shall be lawful for the trustees to settle all account and to compromise, compound, abandon or refer to arbitration any action or proceedings or dispute, claim, demand or thing, proper for such purposes without being responsible for any loss occasioned thereby.
- (b) It shall be lawful for the trustees to borrow money either on the security of any property belonging to the Trust or otherwise to fulfill any or all of the aims and objects of the Trust, and it shall be lawful for the trustees to make this borrowing and the payment of any interest that may result on such terms and conditions as they think fits.

- (c) It shall be lawful for the trustees to apply to the government public bodies, urban, local, municipal district and other bodies, corporation, companies or persons for and to accept grants of money, aid, donations, gifts, subscriptions and other assistance with a view to promoting the aims and objects of the Trust and to discuss and negotiate with the government departments, public and other bodies, corporations, companies or persons, schemes and other works and matters within the aim proper condition upon which such grants and other payments may be made.
- (d) The Trustees shall cause true and accurate accounts to be kept of all moneys, received and spent and or all matters in respect thereof in the course of the management of the Trust property or in relation to the carrying out of the aims and objects of the Trust as well as of all assets, credits and effects of the Trust property.
- (e) The accounting year of the Trust shall be financial year that is year ending 31<sup>st</sup> March every year.
- (f) A Firm of Chartered Accounts, appointed by the trustees shall audit the accounts of the Trust every year.

It is expressly declare that no part of the Trust property or income of the Trust shall be applied for any purpose outside India of for any purpose which is not a public charitable purpose in law and all provisions hereof shall be constructed accordingly.

# 14. **JURISDICTION:**

- (b) Should any legal disputes, claims or litigation within the jurisdiction of the law arise, they will only be considered valid if they are lodged within the precincts of the city of Patna.
